

Workshop Title: "EcoQuest Adventure"

Introduction:

- Prepare a short skit or presentation showcasing your superhero personas, trash-to-treasure creations and the eco-friendly lemonade stand.
- Performances are followed by a friendly competition with prizes for the most creative, eco-friendly and entertaining presentations.

Needed materials for interactive session:

1) SUPERHERO CAPE OR MASK

• Old T-Shirts or Bed Sheets:

old colorful t-shirts or bed sheets. These can serve as the base material for your capes.

• Cardboard:

cardboard from old boxes. This can be used to add structure to the cape or as a base for your superhero mask.

\circ Scissors:

A pair of scissors is essential for cutting and shaping your recycled materials into superheroworthy accessories.

• Fabric Glue or Needle and Thread:

Depending on your preference and materials, use fabric glue for a no-sew option or a needle and thread for a more traditional approach.

• Markers or Fabric Paint:

Add some flair to your capes and masks with colorful markers or fabric paint. Unleash your creativity and design your superhero symbols.

• Old Buttons, Beads or Sequins:

Dig through your old craft supplies or jewelry box to find buttons, beads, or sequins that can be repurposed to decorate your superhero gear.

• Elastic Bands or String:

Use elastic bands or strings to secure the cape around your shoulders or to fasten the mask. This ensures a comfortable fit for your superhero ensemble.

• Recycled Plastic Lids or Bottle Caps:

Get inventive and use recycled plastic lids or bottle caps as embellishments for your cape or mask. They can represent special powers or just add a cool texture.

• Old Magazines or Newspapers:

2) ECO-FRIENDLY LEMONADE

• Reusable Cups and Biodegradable Straws:

colorful reusable cups. Throw in some fun biodegradable straws to make sipping the lemonade even more enjoyable.

• Eco-friendly Lemonade Mix:

Choose a lemonade mix that uses natural ingredients and avoids excessive packaging. Better yet, consider making your own lemonade with fresh lemons!

• Organic Lemons:

Use fresh, organic lemons.

• Rainwater Collection System:

If possible, set up a simple rainwater collection system to use in your lemonade. It's a cool way to highlight water conservation.

• Upcycled Decorations:

Get creative with decorations using upcycled materials. Old banners, cardboard signs or repurposed items can add charm to your stand without contributing to waste.

• Eco-friendly Ice Packs:

Keep your lemonade cool with reusable ice packs. Opt for packs that can be refrozen, reducing the need for disposable alternatives.

• Waste Separation Bins:

Set up clearly labeled bins for recycling and composting. This encourages responsible waste disposal during and after the event.

• Natural Sweeteners:

Consider using natural sweeteners like honey or agave syrup instead of processed sugars. This not only adds a unique twist to your lemonade but also aligns with your eco-friendly theme.
